And, did you know you can immediately call, text or email a member from the slip map?


Just click on any map icon and you'll see the boat details, the members' names and icons for immediately calling, texting or emailing the member!





DYC boasts one of the most active racing communities on the lake. White sail, spinnaker, Kirby fleet -- DYC has it all. On Sundays and Tuesdays we offer our Fun Race series. Those new to sailing have an opportunity to learn the rules of racing from experienced racers, and experienced racers practice their skills. On Wednesday nights the competitive racers take to the lake, with prizes being awarded at the end of the season. Additionally, there are several regattas in which racers participate throughout the season.





## From Our DYC PHRF-LO Officer . . .

## PHRF-LO for the 2023 Racing Season

I wish to invite all racers to plan early and to request a valid PHRF-LO Certificate as soon as possible.

Generally speaking, if you wish to participate in either the Wednesday championship racing, the long distance races or any interclub racing, you will need to receive a valid Certificate.

For the Tuesday or Sunday fun races, if you wish to be scored you will also need a certificate. This certificate gives your boat a handicap rating that allows the Race Committee to score your performance against your competitors.

Dalhousie Yacht Club pays a fee annually, to belong to PHRF-LO based on the number of boats issued a Certificate. Therefore, your racing fee includes the cost of the Committee boat and equipment (marks) and the costs of the Certificates issued. There will also be awards issued at the Sailors banquet at the end of the season for all race series. So therefore "if you use the certificate you should pay for it." For all DYC racing fees refer to the fee table on the web site.

Apply early so we can issue the Certificates without delay. If you are a new owner, haven't raced in a while or you have made changes to your boat/sails, we will need to measure your sails (or you could have your sailmaker issue a note), complete forms and apply to PHRF-LO. But the process takes time, particularly at this time of the year.




