Whether it be the resources for getting boats in the water, docking, enjoying dinner on the waterfront, racing or learning about the many skills associated with safe boating. The DYC is well equipped and its membership and staff are busy maintaining and developing its assets. Of course, our people, their knowledge and willingness to share, is what makes the DYC so valuable as a shepherd to the Port Dalhousie Harbour.

In 2023, I am looking forward to working closely with the Repair and Maintenance Committee under the Infrastructure chair, Jeff Newkirk, on continuing to develop a streamlined process for reporting issues and potential projects around the club and supporting contributions from the membership in getting the work done. If you are interested in learning more about the Repair and Maintenance Committee don't hesitate to reach out to me directly.

There are some specific upcoming projects that I would like to bring to your attention.

Please reach out to me if you are interested in any of the following:

Brutus maintenance: Lloyd Burton has been the force maintaining Brutus and it is our goal to distribute that work load. It would be great to have an individual who could take the lead on maintaining this vessel, with the support of a group of members taking on the work and collaborating, with support outside of the club when appropriate.

Sea Cadets collaboration: The Cadets organizations have been an important part of family coming out of the social restrictions of the pandemic. My older child, Mira 14, is in Air Cadets and my youngest, Remy 12, is in Sea Cadets.

In learning about the Sea Cadets, it is clear that there are various potential mutually - beneficial outcomes from a partnership between the DYC and the Sea Cadets. I have started conversations with the Sea Cadets about how we can collaborate and will be continuing these conversations with meetings in January.

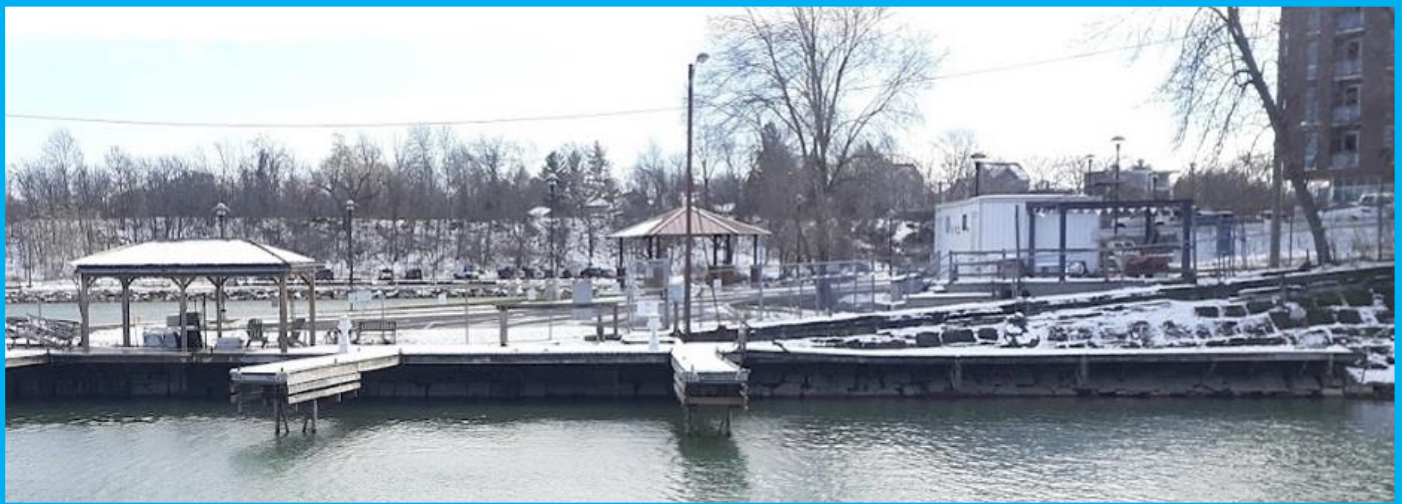

There will be two areas for opportunities, special jobs that either require specialized skill/knowledge or work that can be done at flexible times. Often an email is also, sent out requesting help, especially at times of Docks In/Out, Launch and Haul Out, that will be noted here as well.

This will give us an idea of the number of total volunteer hours DYC requires as a self-help club to keep DYC prosperous.

It will also help us to summarize a rough cost estimate on the savings our members have provided, by not having to hire contractors to do these tasks. DYC is a self-help club, which helps to keep our membership fees and costs/expenses down.

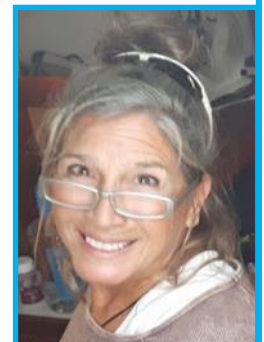

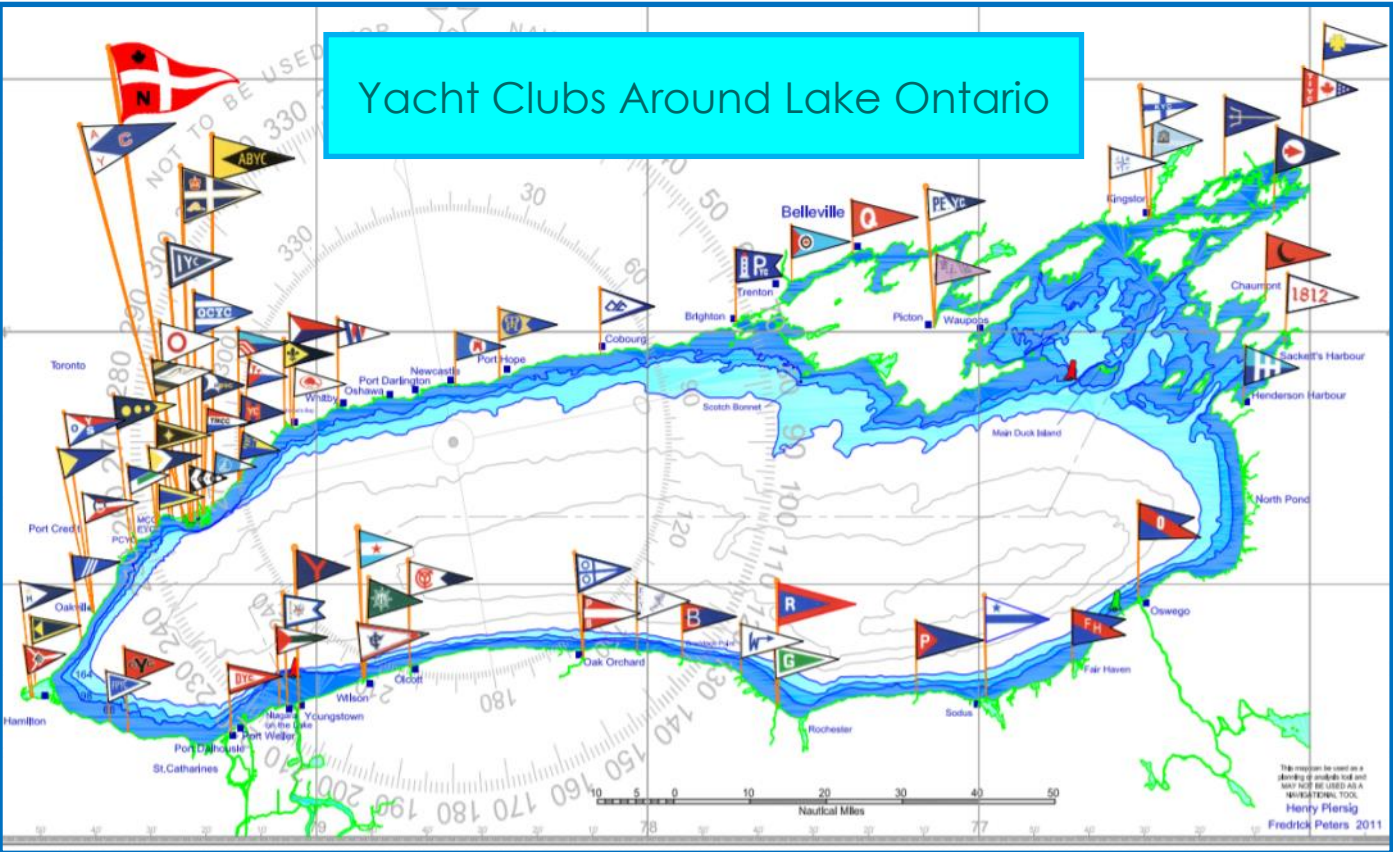

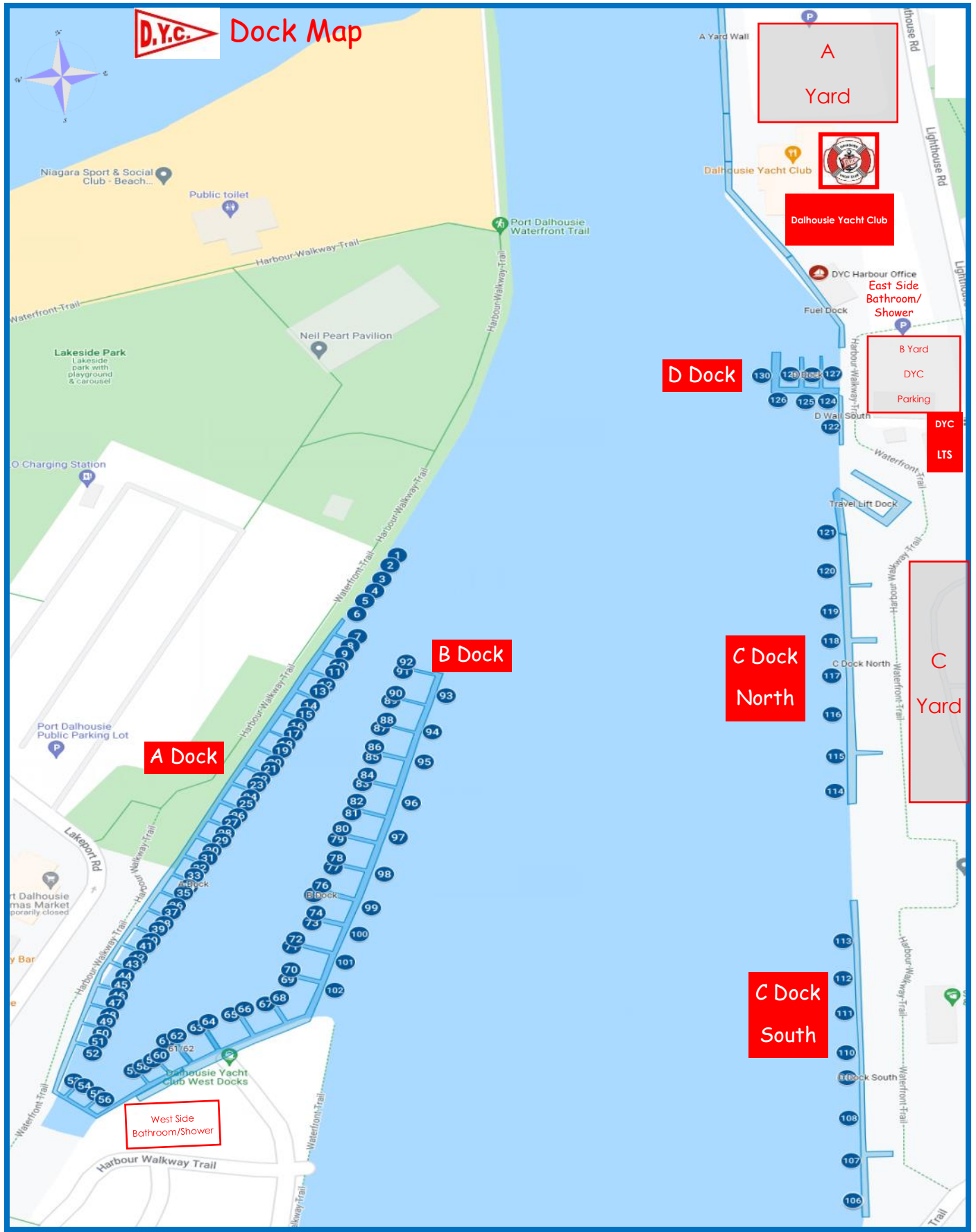
