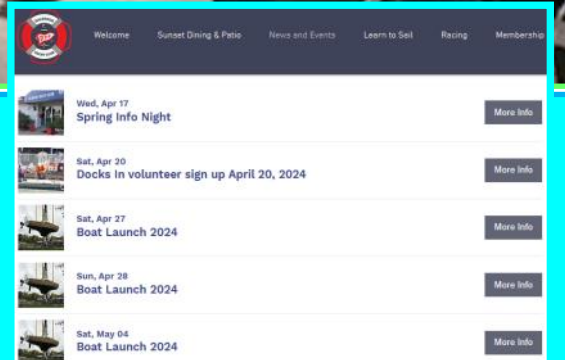

The purpose of the meeting will be to review and approve Articles of Amendment for Dalhousie Yacht Club.

The Government of Ontario has passed the Not-for-Profit Corporations Act, 2010. It has finally been proclaimed as law, and all non-profit corporations incorporated under Ontario law will be governed by the new Act by October, 2024.

Draft Articles of Amendment have been drafted and will be presented at the meeting, and will be available for review at least one week before the date of the meeting. The purpose of the amendment is to bring the charter of the Corporation into compliance with the new Act. This will not affect the terms of the new Bylaw passed at the AGM.

In order to be passed, at least **25% of the Full Boating Members** must be in attendance and the motion to approve must be passed by two-thirds of the Full Boating Members in attendance. In accordance with our new bylaw, attendance may be virtual and details of how to participate will be provided.

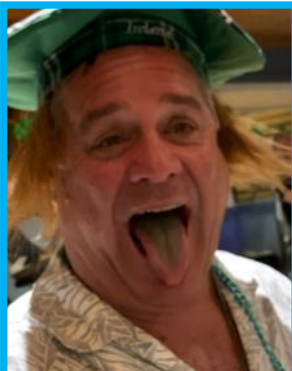
Springing Forward . . .

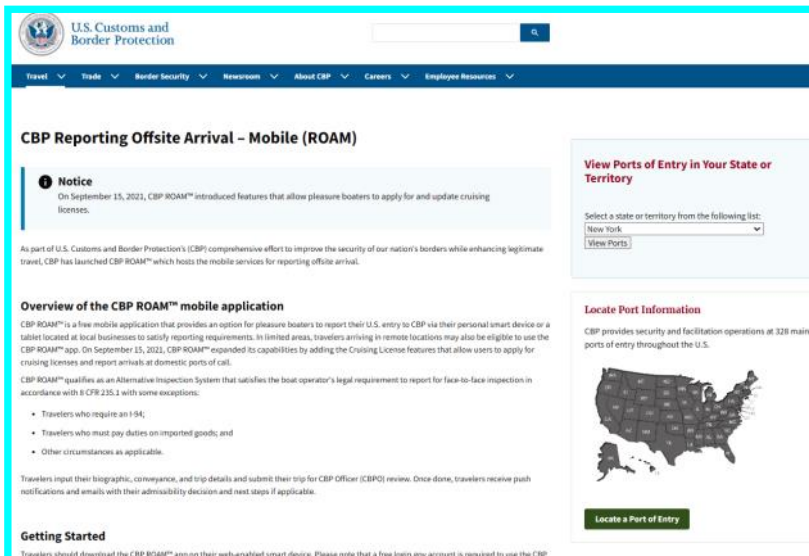
Pleasure Boats - Requirements for Entering the United States - Be Prepared

Boaters looking for a quick way to report their arrival and/or apply for a registered boater program may use the [CBP ROAM app](#). The Boaters may continue to report their arrival using their cell phone or a designated landline.

All operators of a non-commercial small vessel/pleasure boats must report immediately to the nearest [U.S. Customs and Border Protection \(CBP\) port of entry](#) upon arrival to the United States.

CBP has designated specific reporting locations for pleasure boats to report their arrival and be inspected by a CBP officer, which may also be by a video chat. The master of the boat will be directed to the nearest port of entry to satisfy the face-to-face requirement, or report to the nearest designated reporting location along with the boat's passengers for inspection.

A pleasure craft without a cruising license (30 feet or longer in length) must pay an annual decal user fee of \$34.83. [User Fee Decals may be purchased online](#) through the Decal Transponder Online Procurement System ([DTOPS](#)). Best to do this ahead of time. You can provide an email receipt and confirmation that you have applied, if it hasn't arrived in the mail.



For Ease of Reporting into the USA

To use CBP ROAM™ on your personal smart device, download the app from the [Apple App Store](#) or the [Google Play Store](#).

In certain locations, the CBP ROAM app can also be accessed on tablets at partner locations.

In case you missed the changes that were presented at our Information Night December 2022, missed any previous notifications or are a new member . . .

here's a reminder of when you can expect to see invoices for Membership, Storage and Dock Fees in your email.

The balance of your dock fee should have been sent into the office by April 1st, 2024.

Dock invoices were sent out the start of 2024, with direction to send your \$500 dock deposit to deposits@dalhousieyachtclub.com in order that we could begin our dock planning for the season. The remainder of your 2024 dock fees was to be sent in by April 1, 2024.

Any and all requests for changes for docks this season, should have been sent to office@dalhousieyachtclub.com

This year, 2024, we will be sending both Membership Fee & \$500 Dock deposit invoices out on November 1, which will be due December 1st. The remainder of your 2025 dock fees would be due April 1st, 2025. DYC Winter Storage invoices will be sent out this year on July 1, due August 1. This was presented in our December 7, 2022 member information session.

AS A REMINDER, here is a list of important dates of invoicing and when payments are due.

- APRIL 1st - Reminder of dock fees due 5 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR LAUNCH or end of April
- JULY 1st - Winter Storage confirmation & \$500 Winter Storage Deposit request
- AUGUST 1st ~ Reminder of winter storage deposit due end of August
- SEPTEMBER 1st ~ Social Memberships invoiced, due end of October
 - ~ Winter Storage - \$500 deposit = balance due
- OCTOBER 1st ~ reminder of winter storage due 5 days before your scheduled Haul Out date

Reminder ~ Be Prepared

Your dock fees are to be paid in full before your launch.

Your winter storage fee, covers the lift fees of haul out last fall and your spring launch.

If you are not ready for launch and your boat needs to be moved in the yard, then set up again to launch others,

then launched at a later date, unfortunately, that is considered the lift.

An extra fee for lifts outside of launch day lifts will be charged, as it involves the scheduling, organization and effort of several volunteer members to assist in extra lifts.

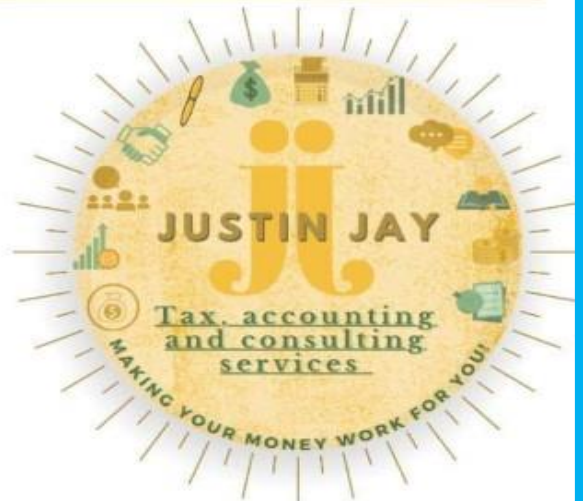

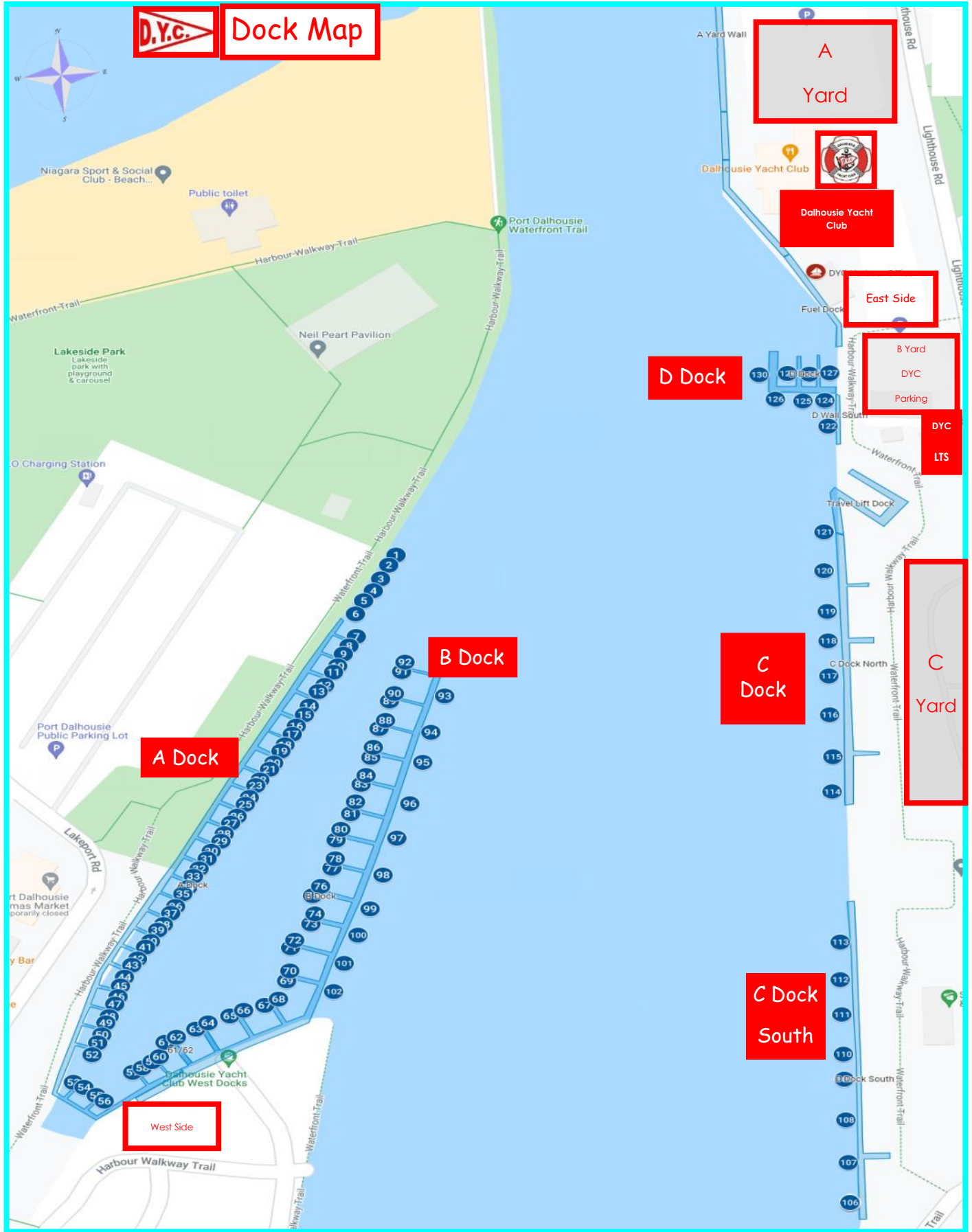
